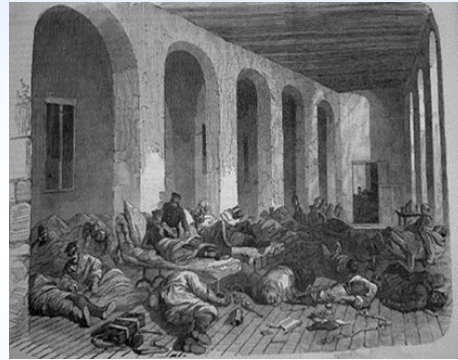


Driver: History

VOCABULARY

Crimean War	A military war that happened between 1853-1856.
Scutari Hospital	The hospital that was in dire need of improvement due to its dirty conditions.
Injured	When someone has been hurt, harmed or damaged.
British Red Cross	A Society that helps people in a crisis.
Medal	A metal disc typically given to someone to award or commemorate their achievement.
Charity	An organisation set up to provide help and raise money for those in need.
Courageous	To be brave.
Battle	A sustained fight between 2 large organisations
Prejudice	An opinion that is not based on reason or experience.

In this topic we shall be learning:

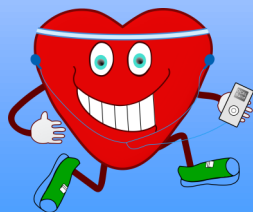
- Who Florence Nightingale was, why she is important and what impact she made to nursing today.

What should I already know?

- In Year 1 we looked at identifying, naming and labelling the different parts of the human body and identifying those that link to our senses.



What is our new learning?

- How germs can pass on to others and that hygiene is important to stay healthy.
- About the basic needs for humans and animals to survive.
- The different food groups and how we need a balanced diet to stay healthy.

Wider Curriculum



Literacy

The children will be looking at fictional superheroes and villains during their Literacy sessions this term. They will be looking at characters within stories and describing them, designing their own superhero character and writing their own superhero story.

PSHE
