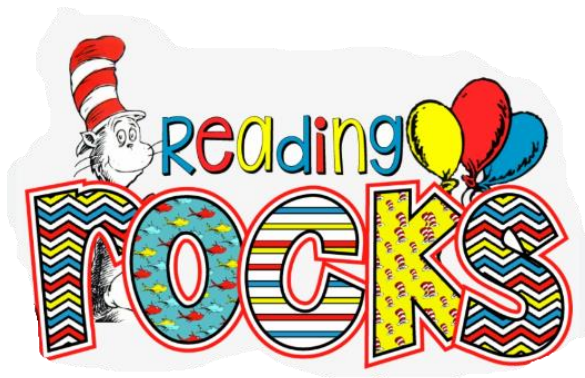




# Remarkable Reads!
