GENERAL REMINDERS

LITERACY

We will be reading lots of lovely stories linked to the topic, as well as nonfiction texts to support our learning.



MATHS

This term in Maths, there will be lots of opportunities to explore the Maths provision and resources. We will be looking at key times of the day and routines/timetables and using positional language to find out where things are in the classroom.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

Our main focus will be learning all about our homes and families. Later on in the term we will investigate the special season of Autumn, including Harvest time.

PERSONAL, EMOTIONAL AND SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT

Throughout the term we will be focusing on settling in, learning about class rules and routines, building positive relationships and establishing behaviour expectations.

We will be talking about what makes us special, celebrating our differences and discussing our feelings and emotions.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

We will continue to develop our fine motor and gross motor skills both in our indoor and outdoor environment. During directed P.E sessions this term, our focus is learning the rules of P.E and finding the different ways our bodies can move.



EXPRESSIVE ART AND DESIGN

We will be learning new songs and rhymes related to our topic, as well as engaging in role play. There will be lots of creative activities, including painting self-portraits!



COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

The children will be encouraged and supported to develop confidence in their speaking and listening skills every day, through group and whole class discussions and small world and role play. We will invite the children to talk about themselves and their families and ask them to bring a special item from home to share verbally with the class.
