### Cake Sale

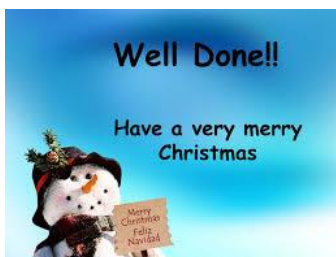
Thanks so much to you all for your support with the cake sale – we raised over £550 !!! We shall be using this money for our children – for things like reading books and supporting our trips.
