This term P.E days are **Wednesday for Yellow** and **Green Class** and **Tuesdays for Red Class**.



Our topic this term is 'People Who Help Us'. The children will be learning all about our amazing keyworkers, including those that work in the emergency services and also our community heroes. We may even be lucky enough to welcome some visitors into class to talk about their important jobs!

LITERACY

We will be reading lots of lovely stories linked to the topic, as well as non-fiction texts to support our learning.



MATHS

This term in Maths, we will be exploring 'To 20 and beyond!' where we will be focusing on building numbers and counting patterns beyond 10. We will also be exploring addition and subtraction further and continuing our shape investigations, including matching, rotating, manipulating, composing, and decomposing 2D shapes!

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

We will be discussing the roles of people in our community and in wider society, including those adults familiar to us. We will also investigate the different modes of transport used, including recycling trucks which will link to our learning about the importance of taking care of our environment.



PERSONAL, EMOTIONAL AND SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT

This term we will be engaging in activities during Well-Being Week to help promote our understanding of our own and others' feelings. We will also be thinking about healthy choices when we explore the work of doctors and dentists. We will discuss our aspirations for the future through the text 'When I grow up' by Tim Minchin.

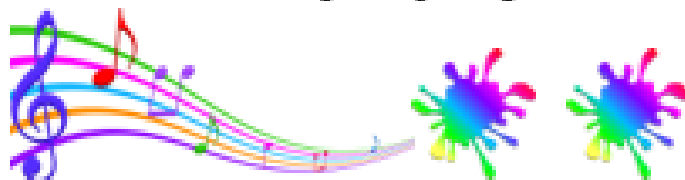
PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT
