Please find below an outline of our learning ambitions for the term but keep an eye on Class Dojo for weekly updates too.

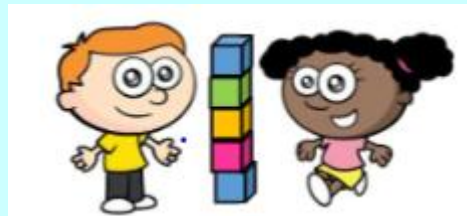
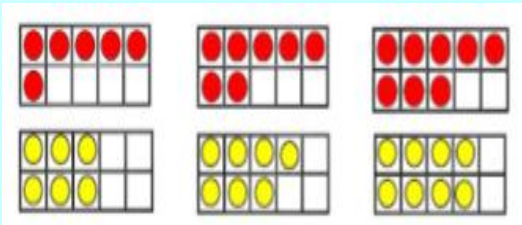
LITERACY

We will be reading lots of lovely stories linked to the topic, as well as non-fiction texts to support our learning. We will be learning new vocabulary linked to the books and encouraging the children to discuss what they notice in the pictures and key concepts about the stories.



MATHS

This term in maths, we will be exploring numbers 6, 7, 8 to represent and different ways to make them. We will also explore length and height, and time.



UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

We will be learning about hot and cold countries linked to our stories. We will look at life in different countries and compare them to our own country.



PERSONAL SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Our focus this term will be exploring friendship. We will explore how to be a good friend and understand the definition of friendship. We will learn the importance of a positive friendship and how to recognise it. We also will learn about healthy eating and why fruits are a healthy snack.



COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

The children will be learning new vocabulary linked to the stories we will be reading. We will be encouraging children to think of their own vocabulary that could describe the weather, animals, and fruits. Children will have the opportunity to act out stories and become the characters.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

We will continue to promote our gross motor skills through our play and movements during outdoor times and PE sessions. Children will be introduced to dance and will learn and develop how to move in a range of ways. We will also continue to develop fine motor skills daily.

EXPRESSIVE ART AND DESIGN

We will be learning lots of lovely new songs and music from countries around the world. We will be acting out stories using the story of Handa. Our art and design work will be inspired by our learning, and we will practise a range of techniques including printing and collage.
