

## Literacy Activities (Writing and Reading)

Complete the weekly phonics plan listed in home learning resources.

Read the story *Back to Earth with a Bump*. Use talk cards to ask questions about the story. Can you think of your own questions? Can you retell the story thinking about the beginning, middle and end?

Can you spot the rhyming words?

Write a sentence about the story using picture stimulus writing sheets.

Challenge: Write your own story about travelling to space. How would you travel there? Which planets would you visit? Who would you meet?

## Creative Activities

Vincent Van Gogh – *Starry Night*. Have a look through the PowerPoint to talk about the artist. Discuss information as appropriate. Look at photo card of Van Gogh's *Starry Night* – what can you see? What colours have been used? What shapes can you see?
